HOW IT IS GOT OUT.

More Than a Score of Editors Had At Work—A Thousand Men and More to Get Out One Issue.

In a great newspaper office, system is indispensable. The work of collecting and exhibiting the news of the world for one day in the regular and compact form it occupies in the morning papers is indeed a Herculean task.

To deal with this irregular mass of facts, rumors and prophecies streaming in from every quarter of the globe and boil it all down into the terse paragraphs which appear next day in print requires through it a corps of able and energetic reporters who hover over the metropolis as eager for news as scavengers for their food—however inelegant the comparison may appear.

Invariably the amount of news far exceeds the capacity of any paper and even if all desirable copy were printed each day it would require three times the number of columns regularly published.

As soon as agreed upon the schedule is turned over to the night assistant managing editor (spare the title) who is the head of the night staff.

Copy after its transformation by these copy-readers or editors, when ready for the composing room, goes to the "schedule desk" where upon a sheet a record of its nature and probable type-space is preserved.
