





ORDER AUTHORIZING \$22,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS

Whereas, the Board of Education of Person County has certified to this Board a resolution passed by said Board of Education on May 6, 1946, showing that it is necessary in order to maintain the constitutional six months' school term in Person County to erect and equip a three room addition to the Roxboro High School building; and
