

## Sermon for SUNDAY, JUNE 23.

GOD IS LOOKING FOR A MAN

And I sought for a man among them ,that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it; but i found none.

## Ezekiel 22:30

Through this period of the past five years we have heard one of the greatest calls for man power the world has ever known. We have sought to set up various organizations and work through them in order to fill this great demand. It has been marvelous as we review the results from these agencies and see the value of their efforts demonstrated. We have heard many new names for these employment agencies, but this is not a new thing. God has been operating an employment agency for the past six thousand years.

Let us go back unto the day when God looked about in this world he had just created, only to find his man had quit the job. There was God with a big world upon his hands with all the beauties that could be offered anyone, yet we hear God
