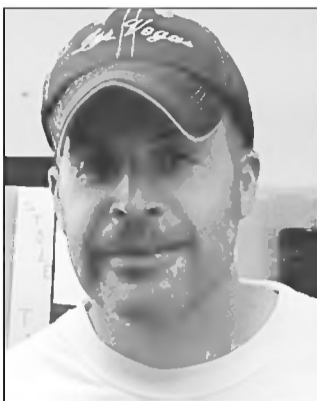

JUNE 26, 1961
