Sherwood. The Chesterfield and Kershaw is the corporate name of the line being constructed from Cheraw to Columbia, to connect the Seaboard Air Line at Hamlet with the Florida Central and Peninsular at Columbia. The road-building from Ridgeway N. C., to Richmond also will have been completed by December 15. and the track will thus be solid from Richmond to Tampa.
