Scholarships \$ Money \$
 Regardless of your academic major, you can receive an annual \$2000 scholarship from the Air Force for your last two years in school, provided you meet minimum academic and physical fitness requirements. With an additional \$100 per month, total annual payment is approximately \$2900. We cannot pay for summer sessions.
 All officer candidates receiving this scholarship will be commissioned upon graduation and will generally incur a four year commitment to the Air Force. You must participate in our program for two full years to be eligible.
