

Senators Won't Give Up Airport Parking

WASHINGTON — Congress has eliminated its free health care and gym privileges, but the Senate on Wednesday drew the line in the parking lot. It defeated a resolution to wipe out lawmakers' free, reserved parking at Washington's National and Dulles airports.

They furiously dashed from the Senate floor to one of the two airports in suburban Virginia to catch the last plane home. McCain, R-Ariz., had a different view of the 124 close-in spaces at National and the 51 at Dulles, which are reserved for the 540 members of Congress, nine Supreme Court justices and scores of diplomats.

The resolution was not binding; it could not have defeated the independent Washington Metropolitan Airports Authority, which runs Dulles and National, to act. However, authority spokeswoman Tara Hamilton said "we are happy to extend that courtesy" to lawmakers but "if Congress expresses a desire that we no longer extend that courtesy, we would follow its wishes."
