1994 record: 10-1-1 (8-0 in the ACC)

Head coach: Bobby Bowden (249-79-4, 176-47-4 at FSU) Home field: Doak S. Campbell Stadium (77,500) Series record vs. UNC: FSU leads, 5-0-1 Returning starters: 7 offense. 5 defense



Keys to season: The Jackets must stay healthy to be competitive, and they have to capitalize on their team speed on offense. If Tech falls prey to injury, it could be another long year in Atlanta.
