"Last year, we were the lucky ones," Bolowich said. "This year, they were the ones who were able to come out well in the beginning."

Lucky or not, UVa. took advantage of Tar Heel miscues and swarmed around the UNC goal. At the 73:00 mark, Fisher dropped the ball off to Andriy Shapoval, who skirted past Drouin and found the empty net to put the Cavaliers up 6-0.

North Carolina joined the scoring six minutes later, albeit inadvertently. A free kick glanced off a Virginia player's head into the net for UNC's lone goal. The Tar Heels face the challenge of

regrouping before squaring off with No. 2 Duke on Sunday, a task complicated by UNC's inexperience in some positions.

"We have to do some corrections, and we have to get the team back together," Bolowich said. "Otherwise, we will experience the same thing next week."

"We have goals for every different line," Keller said. "We try to make sure the starters get two goals, and when the first line of reserves came in, we wanted them to go off the field with a goal."

"We try to keep different goals in mind so that we keep our intensity level. It's just more fun when we dominate and run them off the field."

The Tar Heels must be having loads of fun this year as 12 different players have scored, with Staci Wilson, Beth Sheppard

and Meg Uritus each collecting her first goal of the season against the Tigers.

While not unexpected, Dorrance says his team is still far from the perfection to which each of his teams has aspired and, more often than not, reached. But for a team that starts three freshmen and six others new to the starting lineup, UNC has

surpassed early expectations.

"Right now we're seeing little pockets of flair, as opposed to beating teams with just tremendous passing organization," Dorrance said. "But for us to be the ultimate kind of machine I'd like us to be by the NCAA Tournament, we need both elements."

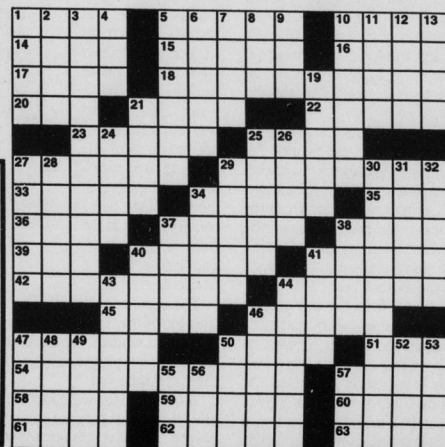
