Howard's interment.

doing such a good job at it."





Former Clemson Coach, 86, Laid to inside Clemson's Memorial Stadiu

CLEMSON, S.C. — Clemson's Frank Howard was buried Sunday next to the stadium he loved, high above the field that ears his name.

Howard who became the school's winningest coach during his 30 seasons, died Priday at age 86 of congestive heart failure after months of declining health. Almost 1,500 friends, family, ex-players and fans turned out to pay their respects to Howard.

"Everybody had some kind of feel for Coach Howard, go by and visit him or tell a story to him, or have him tell them a joke," said Arkansas coach Danny Ford, who led Clemson to the 1981 national title and attended the services.

Also there to pay tribute were U.S. Sen. Strom Thurmond, a Clemson graduate; CBS's Jane Robelot, who worked in the sports information office at Clemson; and
