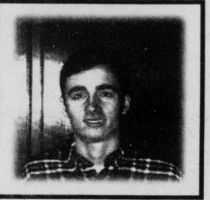

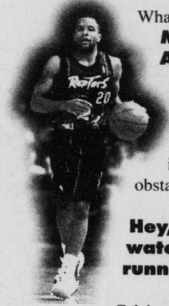


Matt Crawford *What: In The Swim Of Things. Major: Political Science*

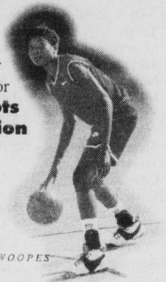
