But none of the Tar Heels' offensive success would have been



possible without their high-pressure defense. UNC midfielders constantly disrupted the Hokie attack, double-teaming passers and forcing turnovers near midfield the entire game.

"The best thing we did today was that our midfielders defended their midfield transition," Slinguff said. "We shut off the next pass, and that was our goal. We double-teamed in the midfield and got the turnovers."

And the Tar Heel scoring attack fed off Hokie miscues. McGinnis and junior midfielder Sarah Dacey combined for eight goals and five assists, while Moore added three goals and one assist.

Since the first win for the program, a 10-4 victory over Colgate on March 6, the Tar Heel offensive output has increased steadily. In each of the Tar Heels' victories, UNC has matched or broken its season-high single-game scoring total. Saturday's 19-goal performance matched the season high achieved against Stanford on March 24.

"I think we've come a long way from our preseason," Dacey said. "We're young, but we've got a lot of fire and emotion. We've slowly but surely improved and become more of an experienced first-year team."
