### Navy salvage ship leaves TWA site after six weeks

SMITHTOWN, N.Y. — With more than 60 percent of TWA Flight 800 recovered and two debris fields mostly cleared, the Navy salvage-and-rescue ship

USS Grasp headed home Tuesday.
The vessel was sent on its way back to its home port in Virginia, and divers and

its nome port in virginia, and divers and the Grasp's sister ship, the USS Grapple, will began focusing on the debris field farthest from Kennedy Airport.

As the USS Grasp prepared to lift anchor, Navy Rear Adm. Edward K. Kristensen thanked about 100 divers and other craw on board. other crew on board.

He told them that they "can walk a little taller around Norfolk for a long,

Divers were running out of wreckage to collect in the two debris fields closest to the airport, National Transportation Safety Board vice chairman Robert Francis said Monday.

"This is little stuff that's being brought up," he said. "There's no large pieces of wreckage out there. ... The size of the pieces is starting to diminish."

Sonar was being used in the two areas to make sure nothing whad been overlooked.

Some sizable pieces, including parts of the tail, wings and fuselage sections, are believed to remain in the debris field

The Grasp, equipped with a robot and special video and scanning equipment, was brought in a week after the July 17 crash to lift heavy objects. The pieces of the plane that have been recovered were being reconstructed at a Long Island han-

Investigators believe the explosion that brought down the Paris-bound jet, killing all 230 aboard, originated in the plane's midsection, somewhee near the center

All but 23 victims have been recov-

The Boeing 747 had been used to transport U.S. military personnel to the Middle East within the last few years, investiga-

But they would not say if they believed that was how explosive substances got on the plane.

"Certainly it's the type of thing we're interested in," said James Kallstrom, the FBI official heading the agency's investi-

"Obviously, ordnance is not authorized to go onto commercial aircraft transporting military personnel.'

### Iraqi hijackers free 184 captives as standoff ends

LONDON — Seven Iraqis seeking political asylum freed their 184 captives aboard a Sudanese airliner Tuesday at a

London airport.
They ended their two-day armed hi-

jacking without bloodshed.

The identity of the Iraqis arrested at the end of a 16-hour drama on Sudan Airways Flight 150 was not disclosed. Police also detained six female relatives of the men and are caring for two chil-

Exile groups said the hijackers may be Iraqi government military advisers too frightened by Saddam Hussein's purges to return home

The hijack of the Airbus 310 - with 171 captive passengers and 13 crew members aboard — ended around noon.

That's when the hijackers, some armed with guns, surrendered after seven hours of negotiations at Stansted Airport, conducted mainly through the Sudanese pi-

"They are not fundamentalists. They are not political or they don't belong to any political party or terrorist group," a man in the cockpit—apparently the pilot -said in a taped conversation with control tower workers, broadcast on ITV

"They are ordinary people. They have been persecuted by Saddam regime. They need protection for their families," the

## Royal divorce finally final; **Charles and Di part ways**

LONDON-Prince Charles and Princess Diana are to end their marriage Wednesday in much the same way they spent it: apart. He will be secluded at Balmoral Castle

in Scotland. She will be at a charity lunch

A court is expected to issue the royal couple a final decree of divorce to end their 15-year marriage, confirming an interim decree that was granted six weeks

Both Charles and Diana indicate they

will have nothing to say about it. That is unlikely to keep the commen-

tators and paparazzi at bay.

Despite Queen Elizabeth II's serious efforts to keep the most determined telephoto lenses away from the family's summer maneuvers at Balmoral, Charles is bound to be the focus of any photographer's camera that he moves within the range of.

The country estate in the Scottish High-lands has always been a favorite August retreat for the heir to the throne, who likes to spend time there fishing, painting watercolors and hanging out with his boys, Prince William, 14, and Prince Harry, 11. They will be with their father on Wednesday. Even when the Waleses were a couple, Diana loathed the rural

She spent her time there taking shopping and lunching trips to London to break the tedium. Wednesday will be another luncheon day for Diana, at the English National Ballet.

It is one of the few organizations with which she retains her official links. She dropped most of her charity work the day after the interim divorce decree.

### **Election plans hit new** snag in former Yugoslavia SARAJEVO, Bosnia-Herzegovina-

Vote officials postponed the most prob-

lematic part of next month's crucial Bosnian elections, admitting Tuesday that plans for local elections have run into trouble.

The postponement came as the Pentagon announced that 5,000 Army troops

will be deployed to Bosnia.

The troops will provide extra security during the scheduled withdrawal of American peacekeepers four months

from now in December.

The extra security reflects a shift from implementing the Dayton peace accords that ended the 3-year-long Bosnian war to planning a safe pullout of the NATO-led peacekeeping force.

Foreign election monitors said voting

ould go ahead for national and regional offices. Elections of municipal candidates, however, would be delayed indefi-

The elections are a crucial aspect of the Dayton peace accord.

Even though the accords provided for possible postponement of the municipal voting, officials had hoped that candidates at all levels could be elected at the same time.

Having elections at the same time would have provided the greatest possible stability for Bosnia.

Bosnia's nationalist parties — especially the Bosnian Serbs — have been accused of trying to fix the outcome of local elections. The accusers say that the Serbs have been informing refugees where they can go to cast their ballots.

### **Clinton still enjoys hefty** lead over Dole in polls

CHICAGO - President Bill Clinton

held a hefty lead in the last two national polls conducted before the start of this week's Democratic National Conven-

Clinton also maintained a 22-point advantage in a New York survey released today.

The New York survey suggested Republican presidential nominee Bob Dole got no public-opinion "bounce" in that several land to the properties and the control to the several land to the properties of the several land to the s enerally Democratic, electoral vote-rich state from his party's convention earlier

The national surveys, like others in the past week, find that whatever convention bump Dole got has diminished somewhat.

Clinton and Vice President Al Gore

were supported by 49 percent.

Dole and Jack Kemp were supported by 32 percent of those polled, and Reform Party nominee Ross Perot by 8 percent in a sampling of 775 registered

The voters were polled Wednesday through Sunday for the PoliticsNow Internet site by ICR Survey Research

The sampling error margin for the poll was plus or minus 4 percentage points. That means that Clinton and Gore could

that means that Childon and Gofe Count be supported by between 45 and 54 per-cent of people polled. That race was 47-34-9 in an Aug. 16 to Aug. 20 Politics Now poll that didn't name

Gore and Kemp. Dole had narrowed the margin to 8 points in an Aug. 14 to Aug. 18 poll. He had been down 24 points in a Politics Now poll that the poll company conducted in early August.
