Wyatt also said political polls could prompt voters to stay home. "If polls show its going to be a landslide for one candidate or the other, people think their

vote doesn't matter," she said. Student Body President Aaron Nelson said students at UNC vote more often than their counterparts at other schools. "Voter turnout isn't low on this campus," he said, noting that in some UNC student precincts, voter turnout was as

high as 64 percent, despite the low turnout for the 18 to 24 age group. Kirti Shastri, coordinator of Carolina Vote Project, stressed that registering students was key to encouraging them to vote. "When students are registered to vote, they turn out in high numbers."

Members of political groups said they felt there was a distinction between being active and simply being involved. "Activism is a spirit," Stamey said. "It's not just what you do, but also how you look at the world." Stamey said the Young Democrats had encouraged activism by working with candidates in local elections. For example, the group has rallied and raised money for N.C. Senate candidate Eleanor Kinnaird. "We've practically moved into her house," Stamey said.

Chris Hayes, chairman of the College Republicans, said his group had participated in many area activities as well. "We campaign for Robin Hayes, Fred Heinemen and many other local candidates," said Hayes, a junior from Raleigh. While each group has actively supported its respective candidates, the organizations have also joined forces in an effort to reach the key college voters.

Among such activities, a bipartisan debate was held on various campaign issues and the groups often set up tables in the Pit to distribute information. "Up until the day to vote, we'll be informing students on issues and making sure those who actually register to vote do," said Jeff Plemmons, co-president of Young Democrats.

This goal may or may not be a challenge come Nov. 5, Hayes said. The college students who really care about political happenings are already extremely active.

"Some students here know as much as your average political science professor," Hayes said.

But Plemmons said more needed to be done at UNC to get students involved. "Students aren't as active as would be ideal," Plemmons said. "We hope to change that in the future." Even though North Carolina has garnered a reputation for being predominantly Republican, Stamey said she felt the voice of the Young Democrats was loudly heard on campus. "If you differ from the norms of the state, you're more likely to be heard," she said.

In contrast, some members of the Young Republicans said despite the prevalent liberalism on campus, their views strongly mattered to many.

"There are a lot more conservatives here on campus than you would think," McMillan said.

Plemmons said he believed there could never be enough student involvement in politics. "We have to get out there and do the grunt work, but it's worth it."

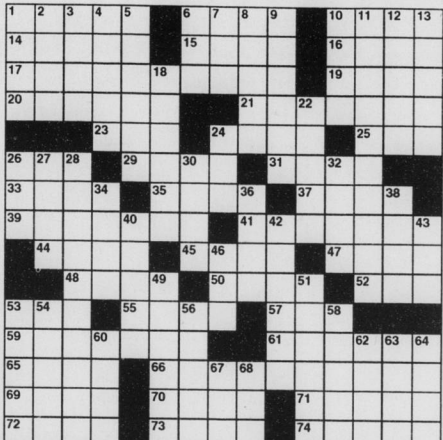
