IN APRIL 1991, the Office for Civil Rights (Region IV) in the U.S. Department of Education initiated a complaint investigation (#04-91-2053) of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The complaint alleged that the University was in violation of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504) as amended, 29 U.S.C. Section 794, and its implementing regulation, 34 C.F.R. Part 104, which prohibit discrimination on the basis of disability in any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance from the Department; and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. Sections 1213 et. seq. and its implementing regulation, 28 C.F.R. part 35, which prohibit discrimination on the basis of disability in public institutions of higher education. On October 30, 1996, the Office for Civil Rights notified the University in part that it had completed its compliance activities and that the University is no longer required to submit periodic monitoring reports.
