1917 UNC President Edward Kidder

- 1932 Graham Memorial Student Union opens. Funding problems cause only one third of original vision to be theralized. First year of operation reports, "different organizations had to be turned away from the use of the building because of lack of room for them."

1969 Frank Porter Graham Student Union opens.
