## STUDENT UNION BUILDING HISTORY

**1917**

UNC President Edward Kidder Graham calls for a structure to enhance student life, "a student club house building large enough to center and contain religious, social, and general student activities for the whole college."

**1958**

First, full-time professional director Howard Henry hired; Henry seeks and receives a guarantee for a new facility and permanent funding for programs.

**1963**

Student Union building project approved by General Assembly, scheduled to begin 1965.

**1981**

Ten years of rapid growth mandates additional space and the 20,000 square foot addition that began in '79 is opened.

**1932**

Graham Memorial Student Union opens. Funding problems cause only one third of original vision to be realized. First year of operation reports, "different organizations had to be turned away from the use of the building because of lack of room for them."

**1960**

Students protest at home of UNC President William Friday for a larger facility to replace Graham Memorial.

**1969**

Frank Porter Graham Student Union opens.

**1994**

Union Board of Directors begins plans for renovation and/or addition to present building for 21st century.
