

# Tar Heels struggle to find net when playing with extra man

There are plenty of statistics that explain the struggles of the North Carolina men's lacrosse team during the 1998 season:

The Tar Heels' schedule, for instance, pits them against six of the top seven teams in the country. UNC has amassed a 1-5 record against those teams.

Or the fact that the Tar Heels are a relatively young team, playing only three seniors in regular rotation compared with eight freshmen and sophomores, adds to the difficulty.

But UNC's difficulties can also be linked to one particularly critical area of the game — extra-man situations.

In 1998, the Tar Heels (3-6) have managed to score on 15 of 53 man-up opportunities, a 28 percent success rate. Their opponents, on the other hand, have converted over 40 percent (18 of 44) of chances with a man advantage.

In Saturday's 15-4 loss to No. 6 Virginia (4-3), UNC capitalized in just one of six extra-man situations. Though the Cavs were penalized six times for a total of five minutes, UNC fired only five shots against goalkeeper Chris Sanderson, several of which were either off target or easily saved.

"We didn't take the right shot," UNC coach Dave Klarmann said. "Sometimes the best play is to move the ball to the next man, especially on extra-man offense."

On the one occasion in which a UNC man-up situation translated into a goal against UVa., the Tar Heels used crisp, rapid ball movement to find freshman attacker Jeff Sonke open left of the crease for a point-blank conversion.

But on each of its remaining five penalty opportunities, UNC seemed overly deliberate, often spending more time setting up its offense than going to the net or looking for shots. UNC also surrendered a short-handed goal to Cav midfielder Drew Melchionni.

Twelve of North Carolina's 14 extra-man goals have come in its four most impressive results — wins against Navy, Loyola and Dartmouth and a 12-11 loss to top-ranked Maryland.

UNC's inefficiency against UVa., however, contributed in its lowest goal output since 1989. After hammering home

three goals in the first period, the Tar Heels went more than 46 minutes with just one score.

"You can't get shut out in lacrosse," Klarmann said. "... Lacrosse is not a shutout game. We went 45 minutes and scored one goal. That's very rare. That doesn't happen in college much."

### UNC adds to '98 slate

The Tar Heels have added another contest to their 1998 schedule. UNC will face off with Ohio State on Wednesday,

April 29 at 2:30 p.m. in Columbus, Ohio.

The Buckeyes are coached by former UNC All-American defenseman Joe Breschi (Class of 1990).

Breschi received first-team All-America honors in 1990 and honorable mention recognition in 1989. He was an All-ACC performer in '89 and '90, both years in which the Tar Heels won the conference championship.

North Carolina holds a 2-0 all-time record against OSU. The two schools last met in 1989, a 29-1 UNC victory.

# 24 Chinese athletes punished for drug offenses

Committee's anti-doping commission. The best-known athlete was female long jumper Xiong Qiying, the gold medalist at China's National Games last October, Xinhua said.

# Puckett injured in single-car accident

MOUNDS VIEW, Minn. — Kirby Puckett, forced to retire from baseball in 1996 after glaucoma left him blind in his right eye, sustained cuts on his arm and head in a one-vehicle rollover accident north of Minneapolis.

The crash occurred shortly before 1:30 p.m. Sunday on Interstate 35-W near Mounds View.

The former Minnesota star, who was driving, was returning with his father-in-law from a fishing trip, Twins spokesman Dave St. Peter said.

Puckett was held for observation at Fairview-Southdale Hospital in Edina and was released before 8 a.m. Monday,

a nursing supervisor said. His father-in-law was not hospitalized.

St. Peter said the sport-utility vehicle rolled over two or three times, but the cause of the accident was unknown. The Minnesota State Patrol was investi-

gating. Dr. Tom Samuelson, a glaucoma specialist who has treated Puckett, said the former player, who played his entire career with the Twins, can see well enough to drive safely.
