ond inning and four more in the third to chase Donovan from the game. Ryan Earey went 3 for 5 with a double and three RBIs in the win. With the hits, Earey extended his hitting streak to 10 games

Tyrell Godwin, who went 3 for 4 in an 11-8 loss at UNC-Wilmington on Tuesday, continued his hot streak with a 2-for-4 performance, including a tworun double in the third inning. Godwin, who has struggled much of

the season, raised his average to .290 with his hot streak. A running back for the Tar Heel football squad, he said a spring football injury has contributed to his recent success

"I strained my shoulder and got away from hitting homers in batting practice," he said. "Instead I've been trying to make solid contact.

"Right now, the injury might be helping a little more than hurting." With UNC's offense clicking, pitch-

er Chris Elmore had more than enough bom for error. Elmore scattered six hits in seven

innings of work while allowing two runs (one earned) to collect his third win of the year. North Carolina's freshman left-hander fanned six Elon batters against only three walks. "We need these games," Earey said.

"We need to start winning as many aspossible."

This weekend, the competition will get tougher when the Tar Heels host

league-leading FSU. The two teams kick off a weekend

series Friday at 1 p.m. The Seminoles enter the series 30-11, including a 9-1 mark in the ACC. No. 12 FSU, which has reached the College World Series in Omaha four of the past six seasons, played against Jacksonville in a late game on Wednesday.


The game marked FSU coach Mike Martin's fourth try for 1,000 wins. The Seminoles dropped a three-game week-end series to No. 1 Miami, denying

Young skips college, chooses draft

CHATHAM, Va. — Korleone Young, one of the nation's top high school basketball players, won't wait any longer to chase the dream he hatched as a gangly Iddy Biddie League player in

He said Wednesday he's skipping col-

lege to join the NBA draft. "I've made this decision based on many hours of consultation with my family and friends," the 19-year-old said during a news conference. "In my heart, I think I can become a good NBA basketball player."

Young, a 6-foot-7 forward, said he's had NBA dreams since growing up as the only child of a basketball-playing mother in the inner city of Wichita. His first grade team was the Lakers, and he wore the same shoes and number - 32 as his idol, Magic Johnson.

Young said he's smart enough to get to Georgetown and UCLA — and still expects to get a degree in business management somewhere. He plans to go to summer school and take night classes beginning in 1999.

Young knows his decision will be crit-icized and said it's upsetting to think some people will assume he's doing it

because he can't pass college courses. "They see a kid jumping from high school to the NBA and the first thing they say is, 'This kid is dumb,'" Young said. "But it has nothing to do with that. It has to do with what I want to do in life and what I can do in life."

Young transferred to Virginia's Hargrave Military Academy from Wichita for his senior season and aver-aged 29.3 points, 11.3 rebounds and 5.1 sists for the Tigers' postgraduate team,

which plays junior colleges, college junior varsity teams and a few of the nation's top high schools.

The Tigers finished 26-1, winning a junior college tournament in Lewisburg and the Nike Super Six tournament in Madison Square Garden.

Young visited Arkansas, Connecticut, Georgetown and UNLV this season, according to Hargrave coach Scott Shepherd, and would have qualified academically had he chosen to attend a college

Young, a first-team Parade Magazine All-American in his junior and senior years, plans to hire an agent, Shepherd said. If Young hires an agent, he would lose all college eligibility. Should Young decide not to hire an agent, he could retain his college eligibility if he is not drafted by the NBA or decided against signing an NBA contract.


