### UNC Wrestlers Reach Penn State Open Semis

North Carolina wrestlers Chuckie Connor, JohnMark Bentley and Corey Bell reached the semifinals before losing Sunday at the Penn State Open.

Connor reached the semis with a win for forfeit against Jamie Carl, a 13-3 major decision against Dave Llarra of Seton Hall and a 7-2 decision against Central Michigan's Devon Gray. But Connor lost a 3-1 decision to Jody Strittmatter in the semis.

Bentley won on a pin and two decisions before falling 6-4 to Pennsylvania's Brett Matter.

Bell's loss came in a sudden death tiebreaker to Navy's Greg Gingselski.

### Terrapins Top Stanford in BB&T Tournament

Steve Francis scored a career-high 24 points, and No. 2 Maryland won its first non-blout of the season, a 62-60 victory against No. 5 Stanford on Sunday in the first round of the BB&T Classic.

The Terps (9-0), who won their first eight games by an average of 32.8 points, took the lead for good at 59-57 with 1:22 to play on two free throws by Francis.

After a turnover by Stanford (4-2), which lost its second-consecutive game, Laron Profit made one of two free throws with 20 seconds left, his first point of the game.

### More NFL Controversy Arises in Jets' Late Win

On a day when he nearly wore out his arm, Vinny Testaverde used his legs to lift the New York Jets to a wild comeback victory. And in this season of officiating bobbles, Testaverde got a kind boost from the head linesman.

Television replays showed Testaverde didn't reach the end zone on his 5-yard sneak on fourth down with 20 seconds left Sunday, but it was ruled a touchdown, giving the Jets a 32-31 decision against the Seattle Seahawks.

North Carolina's women's basketball team used a desperate last-minute comeback and an overtime blitz to top

Florida State, 112-101 on Saturday in Tallahassee, Fla.

Trailing by six with just 28 seconds left, all looked lost for No. 9 North Carolina (9-1, 2-0 in the ACC).

But Juana Brown banked in a 3-point

er and Nikki Teasley drilled a 3 of her own with 13 seconds left, forcing overtime.

In the extra period it was all UNC, as the Tar Heels outscored FSU 18-7.

Teasley paced the team with 32 points and six assists. Brown added a career-

high 28 and Chanel Wright chipped in 26.

FSU forward Latavia Coleman pouted in a career-high 38 points in the game but tallied just three in overtime. Brooke Wyckoff had 19, and Jen Robinson added 18 for the Seminoles.

The game was a breakout shooting game for the Tar Heels, who have struggled all season long to find the touch on their jumpers.

Entering the game, UNC was hitting 40 percent from the field and just 25 percent of its 3-pointers.

But against the Seminoles (2-4, 0-2),

the Tar Heels connected on nearly 54 percent of their shots and drained 9-of-21 3-point shots. Brown led the 3-point barrage by connecting on 4-of-7.

The Seminoles led by as many as 11 points in the first half before UNC rallied to cut the lead to 44-43 at the half.

North Carolina took the lead for the first time with 17:49 remaining in the second-half on a three-point play by Wright.

UNC built its lead to as much as seven, but FSU rallied and took a 72-71 edge with 9:51 left. They appeared to be in control until the final seconds.

## Van Exel Suing NBA To Play in Europe

### Denver's Nick Van Exel and other NBA players plan to sue the league in an effort to play overseas this year.

NEW YORK — Nick Van Exel of the Denver Nuggets plans to sue the NBA, USA Basketball and FIBA in an effort to play the rest of the season in Europe, his agent said Sunday.

Van Exel and several other plaintiffs, including Marcus Camby of the New York Knicks, will file their suit later this week, alleging that the NBA and USA Basketball will not give clearance to FIBA, the sport's world governing body.

"Nick wants to work this year, and other players want to work, but they are unable to accept offers overseas because NBA and USA Basketball are telling FIBA not to clear them," agent James Bryant said.

The hangup, according to Bryant, is that Van Exel would want to finish the season in Europe — even if the NBA lockout were lifted — and then return to the United States as a free agent next summer.

Van Exel, who was traded from the Los Angeles Lakers to the Denver Nuggets in June, has one year remaining on his contract.

Camby, who was traded from the Toronto Raptors to the New York

Knicks in June, also has one year remaining on his deal.

Bryant said Van Exel had two or three overseas offers and Camby had one, although he would not name the teams for fear of jeopardizing their offers.

Commissioner David Stern has said all NBA players are technically free agents during the lockout, but that all contracts would go back into effect once the lockout ended. More than 220 players have contracts for the 1998-99 season and another 200 are free agents.

NBA chief legal officer Jeffrey Mishkin said he would not comment until he had seen the suit.

In other lockout news, more than 100 players took part in a union conference call to discuss the state of negotiations. A union spokesman said the call lasted about an hour and 15 minutes, and several players expressed their willingness to sit out the entire season rather than accept an unfavorable collective bargaining agreement.

"It was calm. There was less raw emotion than on last week's call," said Danny Schayes, a member of the union's negotiating committee.

Also, there was no word as to whether union director Billy Hunter had telephoned Stern or deputy commissioner Russ Granik to inquire about resuming negotiations. No talks have been held since Thursday when the sides met for 10-12 hours of face-to-face discussions and made little progress.

## Holdsclaw Ties Mark in Victory

### Chamique Holdsclaw tied Tennessee's all-time scoring record in Sunday's 74-60 win against No. 16 Duke.

LAKE BUENA VISTA, Fla. — Tennessee had only one disappointed fan Sunday.

With school scoring leader Bridgette Gordon in attendance, Chamique Holdsclaw tied the former Tennessee standout's career mark with a 12-point performance as the No. 3 Lady Vols defeated No. 16 Duke 74-60 at the Honda Elite 4 Holiday Classic.

"I was hollering for her to break it," Gordon said. "I wanted to see her break it."

Holdsclaw's jumper with 10:37 left in the second half tied Gordon's mark of 2,450 points. Holdsclaw will have to wait until Dec. 17, the Lady Vols' next game at Arkansas, to break the record.

"I wasn't really concerned today. Ever since I came to Tennessee, my

focus has been team goals," Holdsclaw said. "I know sooner or later in the season I'll break it. The individual goals are nice if they come your way."

After missing her final three shots, Holdsclaw passed up the record-breaker with 2:32 left. Instead of taking an easy layup, the senior opted to set up Semeka Randall.

"We really hadn't talked about it," said Tennessee coach Pat Summitt. "Chamique is the type of player, she wants to do whatever she has to do to help the team. She's never been one who focused on individual stats, other than to improve her own game."

Teresa Geter had a team-high 17 points and Kristen Clement added 13 as the Lady Vols (6-1) won their fifth-consecutive game and second in the past seven days against a ranked opponent.

Missy Van Gorp had a game-high 22 points as Duke (5-4) had a four-game winning streak end.

"Against Tennessee, you can't play 20 good minutes of basketball ... you've got

to play 40 minutes of great basketball," Duke coach Gail Goetsenkos said.

"Overall, I was pleased with our effort, especially in the second half."

Duke, after trailing 39-24 at intermission, outscored Tennessee 36-35 over the game's final 20 minutes.

Following a sluggish start, Tennessee needed just three minutes midway through the first half to take control. Holding an 11-8 lead with 11:11 remaining, the Vols put together an impressive 14-2 run.

Holdsclaw scored six points, coming on a spinning jump shot and two driving lay-ups.
