

Ervin Named Minority Affairs Director

Ervin will replace Special Assistant for Minority Affairs Harold Wallace who is retiring after 25 years.

His work as chairman of the Chancellor's Committee for the Martin Luther King Jr. Birthday Celebration gave UNC the Making of the King Holiday Award in 1995. UNC was the first university to win this award.

Ervin has been inducted into the Order of the Golden Fleece and the Order of the Grail, two campus honorary societies, and earned a Greek chapter of the year adviser award for work at the Theta Omicron chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi fraternity.

"Carolina is fortunate to have cultivated such a dedicated administrator as Archie Ervin," said acting Chancellor William McCoy.

"His impressive record of service to the university community has earned him the deep respect of students and colleagues from within," McCoy said.

"Under (Ervin's) leadership, we will continue to identify the most effective ways in which the university can

enhance the presence and experience of minority students, faculty and staff."

The Office of Minority Affairs provides programs, activities and services which work to recruit and support minority students. The office also assists in recruiting minority faculty and staff.

Ervin will succeed Harold Wallace, special assistant for minority affairs. Wallace is retiring after 25 years of service in a variety of administrative positions.

"While we are sorry to lose Harold Wallace, who is retiring after a long and outstanding tenure at the university, I am pleased to be able to promote

from within," McCoy said.

Archie Ervin, director of minority recruitment for UNC, was named an assistant to the chancellor and director of the Office of Minority Affairs.

Ervin will assume the position after serving as director of on-campus minority recruitment and as a UNC employee for 13 years. His appointment will take effect on July 1.

Prior to this appointment, Ervin served as chair of UNC's Black Faculty and Staff Caucus since 1995.

He also established the Martin Luther King Scholarship Fund, co-founded the Black Parents Association and assisted academic departments in finding private funding sources for scholarships.
