Archie Ervin, director of minority recruitment for UNC, was named an assistant to the chancellor and director of the Office of Minority Affairs.

Ervin will assume the position after serving as director of on-campus minority recruitment and as a UNC employee for 13 years. His appointment will take effect on July 1.

Prior to this appointment, Ervin served as chair of UNC's Black Faculty and Staff Caucus since 1995.

He also established the Martin Luther

King Scholarship Fund, co-founded the Black Parents Association and assisted academic departments in finding private funding sources for scholarships

His work as chairman of the Chancellor's Committee for the Martin Luther King Jr. Birthday Celebration gave UNC the Making of the King Holiday Award in 1995. UNC was the first university to win this award.

Ervin has been inducted into the Order of the Golden Fleece and the Order of the Grail, two campus hon-orary societies, and earned a Greek
