will be an ideal marriage," Torbush said.
"I've got a tremendous amount of respect for Mike as a person and coach and have developed it over a period of years."
O'Cain's agreement with UNC is a two-year contract worth \$115,000 per year. He had three years remaining - at \$146,000 per year - on his contract at

N.C. State when he was fired.
His settlement with N.C. State calls for the Wolfpack to pay the balance of his annual salary that is not paid by UNC, which next year is \$31,000. O'Cain, who compiled a 41-40 overall record as head coach of the Wolfpack, is also entitled to a lump sum of \$190,000 and can continue driving a car provided by N.C. State until May 30.
O'Cain said that although he is changing sides in a heated rivalry, his loyalty should not be questioned by fans

of either school.
"They made a decision on November 24 that Mike O'Cain would no longer be a part of N.C. State. Not me," O'Cain said. "They made that decision. That's a business decision that they had to make. Now, it's a business decision that I'm making because of the job to come here.
"It's no different than a professor leaving North Carolina and going to N.C. State, which you would never hear about, or a professor leaving N.C. State and coming to North Carolina. It's a

business decision and an opportunity, and opportunities in this profession don't come up that often. There are only X number of opportunities, and you don't pass up one."
O'Cain, who played quarterback at Clemson from 1974-76, helped mold the careers of record-setting quarterbacks such as Shane Montgomery and Jamie Barnette during his 14 years on N.C. State's staff.
He said he is anxious to try to do the same with UNC's Ronald Curry, an athletic, mobile player much like Barnette.
"I'm very excited about working with Ronald Curry and the offensive players that we have," O'Cain said. "The potential is unlimited, and it's our job as an offensive coaching staff to get the maximum out of them.
"As Carl said, don't tell them that we're going to be three yards and a cloud of dust - because we won't be. We're going to be exciting offensively, spread things out and be diverse and creative."

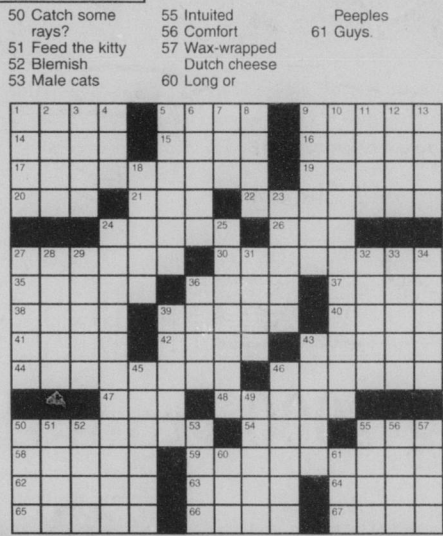

"We made some mistakes that were costly and that we'll learn from."
For now, UNC will have to learn to play without Teasley, who averaged 14.0 points a game and led the squad in assists and steals.
The Tar Heel offense struggled in her absence. UNC connected on 17 of 60 shots in the contest.
Freshman Coretta Brown started in Teasley's place and notched 11 points.
"Openly, everybody said that we're going to put this behind us and move on, but I don't know what everybody else is thinking," Barksdale said.
She said the situation was the furthest thing from her mind, and it showed.
Barksdale poured in a game-high 22 points and 13 rebounds. She scored 11 of North Carolina's first 14 points to keep the Tar Heels in the game.
But aside from Barksdale, the rest of

the team shot 2-for-19 in the first half.
As the poor shooting continued, so did the Tar Heels' struggles. UNC lost its third consecutive game for the first time since the 1995-96 season.
