UNC Crew Hits Water For 1st Time in 2000

The UNC rowing team will open its season Saturday at University Lake in the Carolina Dash, facing Duke in a three-race format of 1000-meter sprints.

The races begin at 8 a.m. University Lake will be open to spectators from 7 a.m. until 10 a.m. solely for the viewing of the races. Admission is free. Parking is limited, but spectators can carpool or take the free shuttle from Carmichael Auditorium, leaving every 20-30 minutes starting at 7 a.m.

UNC came back from losing its first game of the year at Finley Field to defeat No. 18 South Carolina in Game 2.

After falling to South Carolina in heartbreaking fashion in the opening game, North Carolina's softball team needed an offensive spark in the second game to avoid being swept by the Gamecocks.

Enter Michelle Semmes.

The junior shortstop drove in all three of UNC's runs in the second contest, almost single-handedly defeating the Gamecocks.

The team's execution in the finale was in sharp contrast to the opener.

The first game, a 4-3 defeat to the No. 18 Gamecocks (10-6) and UNC's first loss at Finley Field, was marked by missed opportunities.

"We didn't execute, we had some baserunning errors, we didn't put bunts

down, we had an overthrow, and we didn't hit our relay person," UNC coach Donna Papa said.

Down 3-0 in the bottom of the fourth, however, North Carolina began to pick up the offense.

In the fourth, the Tar Heels pro-

duced two runs to cut the deficit to 3-2 entering the final inning.

The Gamecocks scored an insurance run in the top of the conclusive frame, but UNC had a chance to tie or win in the bottom of the seventh. However, Natalie Anter struck out with runners on first and second to end the threat and the ballgame.

"We did battle back after the third inning, so hopefully we learned from that," Papa said.

Game two of the doubleheader was another tight contest. The two teams were tied 2-2 after seven innings and

had to play an extra frame.

As pitcher Erin Joseph (5-1) closed the door on the Gamecocks in the top of the eighth, North Carolina had a chance to do something it failed to do in the first game: convert in the clutch.

Semmes rifled a single up the middle to score Crystal Henderson, giving UNC (15-4) the win and the split.

"There were some good pitches - I felt confident," said Semmes, who was 3-for-4 in the second game.

After UNC completed its split with

the Gamecocks, Papa said she saw signs of improvement.

"We are still taking some baby steps," Papa said, "but I thought the second game showed a lot of character."
