guarding the 3-point line. Basically, every team in the country, when they go to practice, is going to practice their half-court offense. We try to be as disruptive as possible and take teams out of what they practice on a regular basis."

One of the keys to breaking Florida's press will be senior point guard Mateen Cleaves. "You never have a chance to relax," he said. "The main thing for the game is you can't change your attitude."

"I do think we need to get more scoring out of our bench, and I think we have the potential," Izzo said. "As far as wearing us down, I think we'll utilize our bench enough so it doesn't."

Michigan State is trying to become the first Big Ten team to win the national championship since Michigan in 1989. The Spartans' only national championship came in 1979 when Magic Johnson led them to the title as a sophomore.

The Spartans are in the Final Four for the second straight year. They lost to Duke in the semifinals last season.

"That was cool, but we went home empty-handed," Cleaves said. "It's great to get here but you'll always be remembered as a national champion."

Florida is looking for its first national championship while keeping alive the Southeastern Conference's even-year streak. Arkansas won in 1994 and Kentucky won in 1996 and 1998.

Ticket Scalper, Celebs Highlight Indy Weekend

Final Four weekend in Indianapolis brought out the famous and those just looking for a place to sit.

INDIANAPOLIS - The Final Four has reached the same level as the Academy Awards and other Hollywood gatherings - you have to be seen.

The RCA Dome was a who's who of athletes and sports personalities Saturday night. Among the athletic dignitaries in attendance: former Michigan State point guard Magic Johnson and boxing great Muhammad Ali.

Johnson was on hand to cheer on his alma mater in its semifinal victory against Wisconsin. Also in attendance was former Michigan State coach Jud Heathcote, who guided Johnson and the Spartans to the national championship

in 1979. Ali sat near center court for the Wisconsin-Michigan State game and was mobbed by photographers.

Other luminaries included baseball player Sandy Koufax, New York Yankees owner George Steinbrenner and actor William Shatner.

The basketball-filled weekend involved more than just the Final Four games. The National Association of Basketball Coaches held its annual convention in Indianapolis, and the coaches packed the RCA Dome.

Duke coach Mike Krzyzewski, Purdue's Gene Keady and Louisville's Denny Crum were just a few of those in attendance.

The NCAA held various other clinics as well as Hoops City in town. The festivities continued with high school all-star games, including the NABC Nike

Hoops Summit with North Carolina recruit Neil Fingleton that was held at Conoco Field House on Sunday.

While the NCAA tried to promote those appetizers, many of the fans were looking for a way into the RCA Dome for the main course. But ticket scalping, which is legal in Indiana, was outlawed this year in Marion County, the location of the Final Four.

Despite efforts to curb scalping, those who wanted to exchange tickets for cash found a welcoming audience. Many deals were consummated on the sidewalks around the arena with rolls of money changing hands.

Others were more up front about it. During the waning moments of Michigan State's victory, a Spartan fan clad in all green walked past the sea of Wisconsin red and gleefully asked for two tickets for tonight night's championship game. The Badger response was predictable.

And after the Tar Heels dropped their semifinal contest, a Spartan fan stood in UNC's fan hotel looking for tickets for the national championship game.
