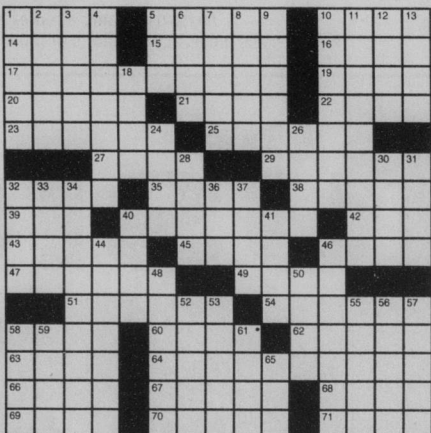

"It's not me who's scamming the people," Ploutis said. "It's her."

Ploutis has also filed a lawsuit with the N.C. Attorney General's Office, suing Kapur for a list of offenses such as defamation of character, breach of contract and punitive damages. Despite the legal wrangling, Ploutis said EMS, Inc. would not leave the 75 students who bought the deal out in the cold.

"I've been calling all the girls up," he said. "We're offering the services to three other salons in the Triangle area."

He also said students who bought the

offer could call the Executive Marketing Systems office. Freshman Jill Fowler said a sales representative approached her with the promotion in front of the Undergraduate Library. "I told him I wasn't interested," she said. "He just kept on harassing me. So I finally broke down."

Fowler said she called Beauty Quest that week for a Saturday appointment, but was told to reschedule it.

"The next week I called again and said I had a certificate," she said. "The guy said I had a fraudulent offer. He said they already had contacted the attorney general about him."

Freshman Julie Myers said more than 20 of her sorority sisters encountered similar resistance after representatives sold

the offer at a Pi Beta Phi sorority meeting. "The sisters who bought the deal" sent out e-mails telling us it was a fraud."

But she said some friends got the same promotion from EMS for a different hair salon and found their offer to be valid. "I'm trying to get the word out there," Ploutis said. "(Kapur) signed my contract, and now she tells me she's not honoring college students."

Ploutis presented a copy of the contract between EMS, Inc. and Beauty Quest Day Spa with Kapur's name and signature on it. But Kapur said the contract did not exist. "There was no contract made."

against proposed tuition increases.

"We have been fortuitous in many efforts to have met with great success," Conner said. "To the chagrin of many, thousands of students across this campus helped me keep that promise."

"Isn't it pretty awesome what students can do when we join together?"

Lenissa Rentas, whose vice presidential inauguration ended her term as student body secretary, praised the ability of the departing officers' solidarity as a team.

"One year ago, five strangers sat in those chairs united by the goal of improving the University," Rentas said. She encouraged the new administration to work with the same zeal for service.

Other officers inducted were Residence Hall Association President Robin Yamakawa, GPSF President Thad Woody, Carolina Athletic Association President Tee Pruitt (his second term) and Student Attorney General Taylor Lea. Senior Class President Jason Cowley and Vice President Sherilyn Black and Congress members were also inaugurated.

A common theme in many speeches was the importance of the combined efforts. "One thing I realized this year is that nothing good happens from just one person," Heinke said. "We had fun, we worked hard and we learned a lot. When I look back on this year, I'll judge it well."
