Henderson led off with a bunt single. She then reached third on a two-base error by pitcher Jamie Smith. Jen Klesaris rocketed a two-strike pitch back to the mound, and Smith knocked the ball to the dirt. But her hurried throw went wide of the first baseman, sending Henderson to third and Klesaris to sec-

ond with nobody out.

Michelle Semmes stepped to the plate next and hit a deep fly ball to right field that looked destined for extra bases. But Kori Jacobson had a jump on it. Running back, she snatched the ball with her outstretched glove, but the ball

"I thought the ball went over the right fielder's head, so I told Crystal to go on," said UNC head coach Donna Papa, who is also the third-base coach. "Then when I saw she caught it, by the time I

could tell Crystal to get back and tag, it

was too late. It was really my mistake.
"I was feeling pretty bad at that point because that would have been the first run of the game. Michelle did her job getting the ball out of the infield, and we had one our fastest runners at third — what more could you want?"

Fortunately for Papa's conscience, more opportunities would come, and the Tar Heels would not squander them.

Natalie Anter, after pulling several high pitches foul, went inside-out on an outside pitch in the fifth and smacked it

into the right-center-field gap. The two out shot scored Henderson and Klesaris for a 2-0 lead.
