UNC even had a rough time in its only win of the series, a 5-4 decision Saturday. Fox was thrown out of the game in the third inning for arguing a balk called on starter Chris Elmore. The runner eventually scored to give UVa. a 4-2 edge.

But the event served to fire up Fox's squad and to settle Elmore down. Elmore allowed one hit during his next four innings of work before yielding to closer Derrick DePriest in the eighth.

"Whenever you see your head coach stick up for you, that's always going to pump you up," said Elmore, who allowed four earned runs in seven innings to improve to 6-1.

Fox might have received the boot in part because of his frustration with Friday's game, a 6-5 loss. UNC starter Ryan Snare and UVa.'s Kevin Shrout traded zeroes until the Cavaliers finally scratched an unearned run across in the fourth, the same frame in which they

registered their first hit off Snare.

Virginia scored the deciding run in the bottom of the eighth inning when UNC's Jay Madeira, who entered the game for defensive purposes, fielded a
