

Hofstra Fies by UNC With 2nd-Half Spurt

The 11th-ranked North Carolina men's lacrosse team lost to 14th-ranked Hofstra 20-12 on Saturday at Hofstra Stadium in Hempstead, N.Y. UNC (7-6) took a 7-6 lead into the break, but the Flying Dutchmen (9-4) outscored the Tar Heels 4-5 over the last two periods. Hofstra scored the first seven goals of the third period before freshman Kyle Bell's goal with 16 seconds left in the quarter broke UNC's scoring drought. The Flying Dutchmen were led in the third quarter by Bob Parrinelli and Joe Kostolansky with two goals each. Junior Jeff Sonke led a Tar Heel run in the fourth, scoring two goals 17 seconds apart to pull UNC within four at 14-10. But four Hofstra goals in the next

5:04 - two by Kostolansky to give him four on the day - put the Tar Heels down 18-10 with 7:18 left in the contest. Goals by UNC's Joel Miller and Chase Martin pulled the Tar Heels to within six, but two Hofstra goals in the last 2:10 gave the Flying Dutchmen the 20-12 victory. Sonke, a 2000 All-ACC attackman, led the Tar Heels with three goals and two assists, while Martin finished the contest with two goals and one assist. Sophomore goalie Kris Blindenbacher had 15 saves for UNC.

North Carolina (39-11, 11-10 in the ACC) scored four more runs in the fifth inning with consecutive RBI at bats by Clay Hooper, Tyrell Godwin, Ryan Mathews and Matt McCay. The eventual game-winning run came in the next inning as catcher Dan Moylan doubled in first baseman Ryan Earey. Before playing first base on Saturday's second game, Earey pitched a solid 6 2/3 innings in the first game to contribute to the 5-3 UNC victory. Reliever Derrick DePriest picked up his second win of the season in 3 1/3 innings of work. DePriest helped himself out by preserving a 3-2 tie with a heads-up defensive play. DePriest foiled a squeeze attempt by the Blue Devils (14-36, 4-17) by fielding the bunt and getting the ball to Moylan. Moylan then ran down Duke's Jeff Becker before throwing the batter, Wes Goodner, out at second base to complete the inning-ending double play. "If they execute the squeeze in the last inning, we probably lose," Fox said. "Some of those bad things that happened to us at Wake Forest with not fielding bunts made our guys concentrate a little bit harder. It can cost you

games if you don't make those plays." The Tar Heels took the lead in the top of the 10th off RBI singles to right field by Godwin and Mathews. Godwin finished the day 2-for-5 with two RBI. "I think we played really well," McCay said. "It's what we really need because last year about this time is when we were struggling, and we need to get it going for the ACC tournament and for the rest of the season."

Paul Earns ACC Honor As League's Top Coach

North Carolina men's tennis coach Sam Paul has been named ACC Coach of the Year for the second time. Paul's Tar Heels finished second overall in the ACC with a 6-2 record and advanced to the finals of the ACC Championships before losing to Duke. UNC senior Tripp Phillips and sophomore Marcio Petrone were named to the All-ACC team. Phillips, UNC's top-seeded player, has compiled a 20-5 record. Meija Earns All-ACC as a Freshman North Carolina freshman Marlene Meija has been named to the All-ACC team in women's tennis. She is the lone Tar Heel on the 13-member squad. Meija, who played most of the year as the Tar Heels' top seed, has a team-best 22-13 singles record. Meija, a native of Lansdale, Pa., also

teamed with junior Erin Niebling to comprise the Tar Heels' top doubles tandem. They own a record of 10-8, and Meija has a 17-14 overall doubles mark, also best on the team. She is the first Tar Heel to earn the honor since senior Jeni Burnette was named to the 1997 All-ACC squad. UNC freshman Marlene Meija compiled a 22-13 record in singles as UNC's top seed for most of the season.
