Wrestling Prepares for ACC Tournament

Since the mid-1990s, the North Carolina wrestling program set the bar for the rest of the ACC.

The Tar Heels have won four consecutive ACC titles and have regularly sent competitive wrestlers to NCAAs.

This season, UNC has looked vulnerable. The Tar Heels posted an 8-5 regular season record, including a season-ending loss to N.C. State.

In addition to shaky mat performances, UNC has had other distractions. Starter Chuckie Connor quit the team in

February, and a multitude of wrestlers have been sidelined by injuries.

"This season has had a lot of ups and downs," UNC coach Bill Lam said. "But the team has stuck together, and we're ready to defend our title."

What better place to do that than in the friendly confines of Carmichael Auditorium?

The ACC tournament, along with the Colonial Athletic Association and Southern Conference tournaments, will begin Saturday morning at 11 a.m.

"We're glad it's not just the ACC," John Mark Bentley said. "It'll be bigger with more than just one row of fans. We

hope we can draw off that excitement."

UNC has four wrestlers who will be defending ACC titles - Bentley, Corey Bell, Clint Osborn and Matt Kenny - and are heading into the event with a heightened sense of confidence.

"We thought we were going to do better than we did this year," Bentley said. "But we have come together, as we usually do this time of year. Last year it was the same type of thing. We weren't favored then, but we are a better tournament team than we are a dual meet team."

Osborn, a junior, will have the toughest road to a title, as No. 14 Zach Breitenbach will grapple for N.C. State

in the 197-pound class.

Individual titles, however, don't make all of the difference in tournament events.

"We need to win the top spots but focus too on second and third place fin-

ishes," Lam said. "They are the ones that will win it for us."

WILMINGTON - The North Carolina softball team split a doubleheader with UNC-Wilmington on Thursday, winning the first game convincingly 5-0, but dropping the second 2-1 in eight innings.

In the first game, the Tar Heels pounded out 14 hits while pitcher Michael Parrott limited UNC-W to just five hits in the first game.

Parrott, who improved to 6-0 with the shutout, struck out six and also hit a solo home run in the sixth inning.

In the second game, the Seahawks won the game by scoring two runs in the bottom of the eighth.

It was the Tar Heels' first extra-inning contest of the season.

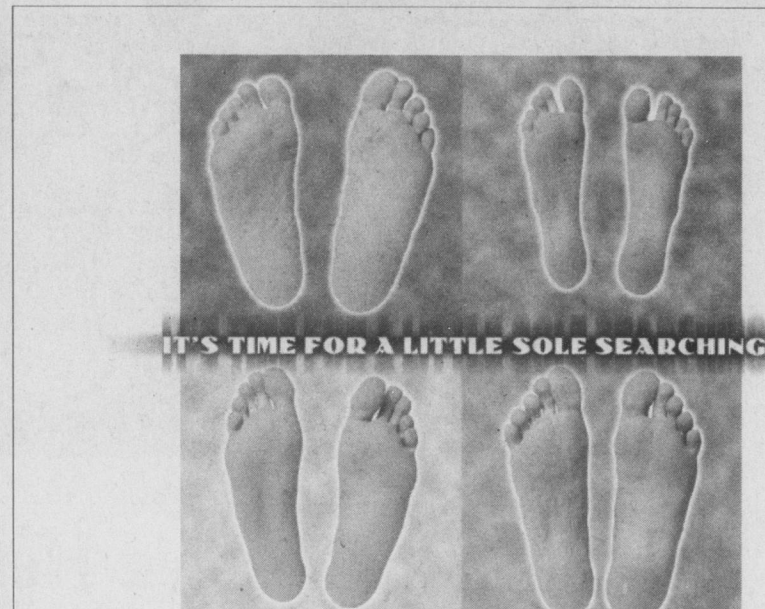
