

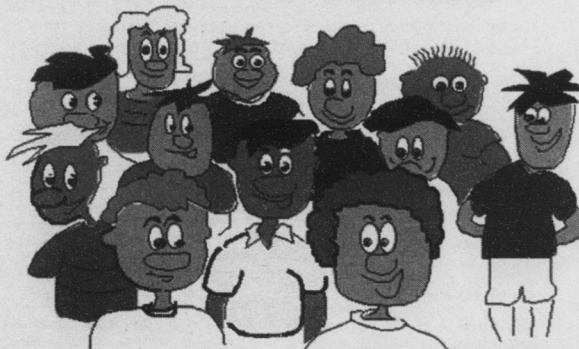

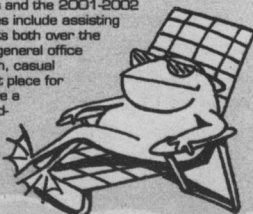
Habitat for Humanity of Moore County
