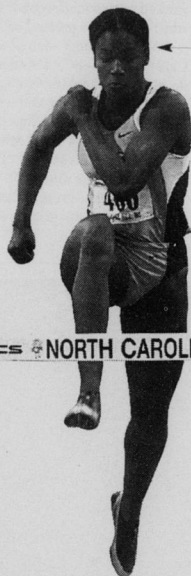

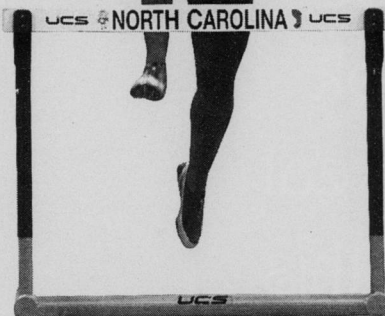
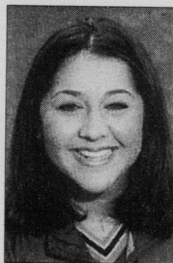


A Leg Up
