The Tar Heels (17-8, 8-3 in the ACC) led throughout in all three matches, and Kendrick Bunn and Kate Pinchbeck clinched the doubles point at flight three with an 8-6 victory.

"We played great doubles today," Callen said. "Our number one, two and three teams played extremely well."

The singles proved to be a different story for the Tar Heels. McCain, ranked third in the nation, dominated Pinchbeck at No. 1 singles en route to a 6-0, 6-3 victory.

"She just played too good," Pinchbeck said. "Today wasn't my day."

On the adjacent court, the No. 2 singles match was just as easy a win for the Blue Devils (26-2, 11-0 ACC) as Amanda Johnson defeated Marlene Mejia 6-3, 6-0.

"The first time (I played Johnson), it was three sets, and I just haven't been able to be in the same mentality since then," Mejia said. "I have to give credit to her — she gets on top of the ball and plays really well."

After losing those two matches, in addition to Tanya Markovic's 6-1, 6-2 loss at No. 6 singles, UNC needed Kendall Cline to come back from a 5-0 second set deficit to have a chance.

After breaking the serve of Julie DeRoo to come back to 5-1, Cline lost two game points and DeRoo smashed a winner down the line to secure the victory for the Blue Devils. The Duke team ran onto the court and hugged DeRoo, while the Tar Heels could only look on.

"Me and Kate (Pinchbeck), we looked at each other and we really wanted this, because it is our last year," Mejia said.

But after pausing, she reconsidered. "Being in the finals, that's not bad at all. It's just another day." UNC made it to the title match by sweeping both Florida State and Clemson in the first and second rounds, respectively.

While failing to defend its ACC championship, the Tar Heels found the performance of Aniela Mojzis uplifting. Mojzis, who was 6-1 in the ACC at No. 3 singles during the year, finished out her tournament with a straight-set win against Saras Arasu.

The Tar Heels will need Mojzis to keep up her excellent play in the NCAA Tournament, as it is likely that UNC will host the regional rounds.

"It will be really, really fun to have the first two rounds (of the NCAA Tournament) in Chapel Hill," Callen said.

"I'm looking forward to the postseason. (We will get) some rest right now and get back to work next week."

double, a Blake two-run homer that landed in the Ehringhaus parking lot and another Cleveland two-run bomb off the scoreboard, the Tar Heels had a 7-3 lead, and they never looked back.

"I think, for our team, it was really important (to have an early lead)," said Blake, who was 2 for 3 with four RBI on Sunday. "We're not afraid to get down and come back, but we're a whole different team when we're up in the first couple innings."

Bakker maintained his control after the jittery first game. He tossed five more innings, allowing only two hits and no runs.

"I thought he was throwing his best at the end," Fox said. "We really debated about whether or not

we should've let him go seven."

Bakker had thrown 77 pitches through six and said he had enough to throw nine innings, but Fox turned the ball over to the bullpen to start the seventh.

Three relievers combined to close out the game, giving Bakker his sixth win of the season.

In game two Saturday, Duke roughed up UNC starting pitcher Adam Kalkhof for four runs in the third inning to give the Blue Devils a 4-2 lead.

But UNC answered right back, grabbing five runs in the bottom of the third to take a 7-4 lead, which the Tar Heels would never relinquish. They went on to an 11-5 win.

In Saturday's first game, Duke jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the second inning, but the Tar Heels clawed back, tying the score at 2-2 in the fifth, then taking the lead for good in the sixth, 4-2. Cleveland's RBI double in the eighth gave UNC an extra insurance run and UNC went on to a 5-3 victory.

"Well, Carolina's better than us right now," said Duke coach Bill Hillier. "I give a lot of credit to their hitters. Their hitters took a lot of pressure off of their pitching. They

hit it a ton."

The Tar Heels have swept their last two ACC series and are riding a nine-game winning streak into Tuesday's non-conference tilt against Elon, before another ACC series at N.C. State next weekend.

While Duke is all alone as the bottom feeder of the ACC (Maryland defeated Clemson twice this weekend), having dropped 16 consecutive conference games dating back to last year's ACC Tournament, Bakker said it was still big to pick up three conference wins.

"Any time you can sweep three games in an ACC series it's important," Bakker said. "That's two weekends in a row now, so we're just looking forward to N.C. State next weekend."

Entering the second round, UNC led the Demon Deacons by a 3-stroke margin atop the team standings. However, the Tar Heels could not match the 6-under 282 completed by Wake Forest Saturday and fell behind by a stroke.

Both UNC and Wake Forest struggled in the final round. Several balls hit into water hazards doomed North Carolina while Wake Forest suffered from a poor day by its best golfer, Haas, who was 4 over on the last day of competition.

With the leaders stumbling, Clemson was able to overcome a five-stroke deficit following the first two rounds by shooting a 3-under 285 on Sunday to take the team championship.

"Obviously, we would have liked to have won," Inman said. "But, we were right there the whole week, and I'm proud of them for that. I'm really proud of Richie for going out and winning one of the biggest tournaments he can play in."

"He's been playing great golf, he's hitting the ball where he's looking, he's making putts, he's playing smart, so there's no reason he can't win any tournament he plays in."

Treis and the Tar Heels hope to improve on their recent finishes as NCAA regional play approaches.

Said Inman of the Tar Heels' national championship hopes, "I like where the team is and I think they do too."
