dent in Congress They said President Bush's campaign staff, headed by chief campaign strategist Karl Rove, is showing increased support for Rep. Richard Burr, R-N.C.

Burr plans to run for the Senate seat occupied by Democratic presidential candidate Sen. John Edwards

Thad Beyle, a UNC professor of political science, said he thinks Bush also will have a hand in the N.C. governor's race, supporting whoever ultimately emerges as the

In 2002, Democrats lost seats in an already Republican-owned House, the Senate fell to the GOP and Republicans gained enough seats to maintain the majority of the nation's governors — all detonated by Bush in a midterm elec-

Bush had to gamble his popularity in 2002 in order to hit the campaign trail, but he does not face that risk in 2004.

"It's very unusual for a president to campaign during a midterm elec-tion," said Michael Munger, chairman of the Department of Political

tions in every state, Munger said. Democrats have 17 Senate seats up for grabs in 2004, including the one in North Carolina and in other important states such as Florida,

important states such as Florida, New York and California. Bush's political team has taken an exceptionally strong interest in Senate seats in North Carolina, said Ferrel Guillory, director of UNC-Chapel Hill's Program on Southern Politics, Media and Public Life.

"Votes in the Senate have much more to do with President Bush getting his legislation through, gethis court appointments

through," he said.

North Carolina largely because of the state's voting history. N.C. voters have picked the Republican presidential candidate since after 1976, when they voted for Democrat Jimmy Carter.

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The Bush administration is making little headway in its new efforts to draw other nations into contributing peacekeeping troops to Iraq by having the United Nations endorse the operation.

By all accounts, the U.S. insis-

tence on controlling all troops in Iraq has run into other countries' demands for greater U.N. control over decisions in Iraq.

Yet, a State Department official said Thursday the administration

intended to continue to seek input on a proposed resolution in which the United Nations would provide a mandate for current and additional peacekeeping troops from other countries, under U.S. command.

U.S. still will seek U.N. resolution

U.S. diplomats at the United Nations informally discussed the


idea with other governments.

The U.S. goal is to have a resolution ready toward the end of
September for the annual special session of the U.N. General Assembly, the official said, on condition of anonymity.

At the State Department, deputy spokesman Philip T. Reeker indicated the process of drafting a resolution was in motion. "We are looking at language that may offer additional encouragement to others" to contribute troops, he said.

On Thursday, French Foreign Minister Dominique de Villepin called for the deployment of a U.N.-run international force in Iraq, arguing that merely increasing troops under U.S. and British control would not be enough.
