# Iraqi police, residents | Violence disrupts elections return to troubled city

FALLUJAH, Iraq — Iraqi security forces and civilians who fled days of street fighting in Fallujah began to return Tuesday in a critical test of an agreement between U.S. officials and local leaders to end the U.S.

siege of the rebellious city.

A U.S. military-run radio station urged residents to hand over heavy weapons to Iraqi security forces or at the mayor's office.

It was not yet known if guerrillas would abide by the call to surrender their arsenals. U.S. commanders have warned Marines might launch an all-out assault to take the city if

the insurgents don't disarm.

By midday Tuesday, as many as 200 members of the Iraqi security forces had returned to their jobs.

a Marine checkpoint to enter the city in the afternoon. Iraqi families lined up there as well to go home.

As part of a deal announced Monday, the military agreed to let 50 families per day back into the city, but people kept showing up after that limit was reached.

Marines announced through

translators that that was all for today. "Come back tomorrow, we will begin letting in families at 9 a.m." About 150 people had to be turned away, said Capt. Ed Sullivan.

About a third of the city's 200,000 people fled during the two-week siege that killed at least 600 Iraqis, hospital officials said. Iraqi policeman Maj. Khamis

Suleyman said he expects Iraqi

security forces to begin searching houses for weapons.

Much depends on whether the

Fallujah civic leaders who reached the deal with the Americans can persuade the insurgents to disarm.

For the city's guerrillas, any hand-over of their heavy weapons would mean weakening, if not end-ing, their months-long resistance against the U.S.-led occupation. The insurgents have worked hard to build up their arsenal and hide it.

Before dawn Tuesday, gunmen in Fallujah opened fire on a Marine patrol near the Euphrates River, Capt. Jamie Edge said. Marines and gunmen exchanged fire for about five minutes, Edge added. There were no immediate reports

NEW DELHI — India's parliamentary elections got off to a bloody start Tuesday, with at least 11 people killed and 18 injured amid clashes with separatist and communist guerrillas.

Taking credit for a booming economy and new hopes for peace with Pakistan, the coalition of Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee looked set to return to power for another five years.

A paramilitary soldier guarding a polling station at another site in the state was fatally shot by militants. Six civilians, including two poll workers, were wounded when a bomb exploded elsewhere in Jammu-Kashmir.

A car with Indian journalists and human rights activists on their way to monitor polling stations exploded when it ran over a land mine in Kashmir. The driver and a human rights activist were killed and four others were wounded.

Islamic militants opposed to India's control of the Himalayan region have threatened attacks on anyone participating in the elections, and a dozen people were killed during the campaign.
Police said they killed a suspect-

ed Maoist rebel in a shootout and a magistrate traveling to a polling station was killed when his jeep triggered a land mine in eastern Jharkhand state.

Maoist rebels have ordered an election boycott in Jharkhand and neighboring Bihar state, where a voter was injured when a bomb exploded outside a polling station.

Gunmen killed a man on his way to vote in Arah, 25 miles west of Patna, the capital of Bihar, police said. Just outside of Patna, a polling agent was shot to death, police said. Elsewhere in the state, suspected Maoists threw handmade bombs at the house of a local

political leader; no one was injured.

Four soldiers on poll duty also were killed and three others injured when the People's Liberation Army attacked them near the Myanmar border overnight, according to the Press Trust of India.

Despite the violence, millions were expected to cast ballots.

The massive vote in the world's largest democracy, with more than 660 million registered voters, will be staggered in five phases over three weeks ending May 10. Vote counting starts May 13.

Some 175 million citizens were eligible to vote in 16 states and territories Tuesday, with 140 of the 543 elected Parliament seats at stake in the first phase.

About 400,000 police and troops were deployed to protect candidates, voters and poll workers from attacks by insurgents opposed to the elections
