# License examiner indicted Miller stresses leftist pedigree

ASHEVILLE - A former te driver license examiner was indicted by a federal grand jury on charges she issued more than 100 es, permits and identification licen

cards for up to \$1,000 apiece. Court documents allege former Division of Motor Vehicles worker Renee Friedman Jones, 51, entered into an agreement with two drug dealers to issue state documents to people ineligible because of criminal convictions, immigration status or lack of vehicle insurance.

The indictment alleges Isidro Hernandez-Ramos and Jaime Arroyo Resendiz split the proceeds with Jones from people seek-ing fraudulent licenses, learner's permits or identification cards. Hernandez-Ramos and Resendiz have not been charged with helping to issue the licenses and permits. Hernandez-Ramos would call

The indictment said in one case, a man who was ineligible for a license because of a conviction was sent to Jones by Hernandez-Ramos. The man paid Hernandez-Ramos \$1,000 and received a birth certificate in the name of Jose Elias Fontan Reyes and fictitious insur-

court in Asheville until late last ance paperwork. He has not been charged. According to prosecu-tors, he presented the paperwork to Jones, which had specific markings in the corner. After he took the computerized and driving tests, Jones issued a license to him in the name of Reyes on Jan. 13.

In another alleged instance, a woman described in the indictment as an illegal immigrant from Honduras had a learner's permit, but repeatedly failed the driving

Resendiz directed the woman to ones, who allowed her to perform the driving test in a parking lot and then issued a driver license. The woman paid Resendiz \$500.

Resendiz was arrested in February on charges of possession with intent to sell and distribute cocaine and marijuana.

A month later, Hernandez-Ramos was arrested on the same charges, according to federal indictments.

THE ASSOCIATED PRESS WASHINGTON, D.C. Democratic Sen. Zell Miller has a message for critics who contend he is a longtime closet Republican. When he casts a vote for President Bush in November, it will be his first for a

Republican in 52 years as a voter. Miller, tapped to deliver the keynote address at the Republican National Convention next week, revealed his unanimous allegiance to Democrats in an interview Tuesday with The Associated Press

"I have never voted for a Republican in my life," the former Georgia governor said. "I have supported every Democratic campaign since 1952. I have voted for hundreds of local and state Democratic candidates.

There is no one that has worked harder or longer in the vineyards of the Democratic Party."

Miller's endorsement of Bush and his selection as the GOP Convention's keynote speaker has sparked outrage from many Democrats. Rep. John Lewis, D-Ga., suggested that Miller, who retires from the Senate in January,

should switch parties. "If you feel that way and feel that strongly, he just should go and become a Republican," said Lewis, a longtime Miller friend and the dean of the state's congressional delegation.

Party chairman Terry McAuliffe, who has sparred with Miller for years, called him "an elephant in donkey's clothing," referring to the Republican and Democratic mas-

"If these folks want to call me a traitor, do they have that kind of record in the Democratic Party?" Miller said.

"I am voting for a man I have tremendous confidence in as our

commander in chief. Give me a break about this business about calling somebody 'an elephant in donkey's clothing."

Miller was an outspoken sup-porter of Bill Clinton in 1992. He even gave the keynote for Clinton at the Democratic Convention that year in Madison Square Garden, the same place he'll deliver his speech to Republicans on Sept. 1. Although he says he voted for

Clinton in 1996 and Al Gore in 2000 against Bush, he resisted talking publicly about those races, stirring speculation about whom he chose in the privacy of the voting booth.

He said he supported Gore four years ago "because I was a loyal Democrat." He said he had a change of heart because of the

Sept. 11, 2001, terrorist attacks. Even after that, in the 2002 election, Miller gave television endorsement ads for various Georgia Democratic candidates, including Sen. Max Cleland and Gov. Roy Barnes, both of whom

lost their re-election campaigns. He said he did it because they ere good friends. Miller is refus-

ing to do any television ads for any candidates in Georgia this year. Democrats contend Miller's political transition started long efore the terrorist attacks. They point out that his Senate voting record has sided mostly with Republicans since almost his first day, when he was appointed by Barnes in 2000 to replace Sen. Paul Coverdell who died while in office.

"Regardless of what Senator Miller has been calling himself, he has spent his time in Washington voting with the Republican Party against Georgia's working fami-lies," said Bobby Kahn, Georgia's Democratic chairman.
