## Tar Heels do not foresee setback

The 2003 North Carolina women's cross country team finished first at the ACC Championship, first at the NCAA Southeast Regional Championship and eighth at the NCAA Championship.

That 2003 team had Shalane Flanagan.

The 2004 team doesn't. After four years of domination, Flanagan, the 2002 and 2003 individual NCAA champion, has exhausted her tenure as a cross-country superstar.

After losing its star, one would assume that the team would be in a rebuilding year.

Think again. "We've obviously lost a key part of our success the past four years, but in

a lot of ways, we can be even better," said Coach Michael Whittlesey.

The coach's confidence stems from the fact that this team has something last year's team lacked: depth.

From top to bottom, the team is expected to show improvement.

Leading the team are junior Carol Henry and senior Erin Donohue.

In 2003, Henry finished second behind Flanagan at both the ACC and NCAA Regional Championships. Henry also had a top-10 finish at last year's NCAA Championships, placing seventh.

Donohue was third at the NCAA Regional Championships in 2003 and 31st at the NCAA Championships. This season, however, she has goals of getting even better.

"I've put in a lot of miles this summer and hope to improve on my 31st finish at nationals last year to help the team," Donohue said.

With those two women, Whittlesey thinks he has the necessary speed at the top.

The keys to the team's improvement, however, will be the middle runners. This is where the team's depth will prove to be important.

In 2003, Meghan Owen and Megan Kaltenbach were both freshmen. The two showed promise but struggled with consistency throughout the season.

"Last year, they were dealing with being freshmen and the new experience of not being the number one runner," Whittlesey said.

"Now that they've gotten through their transition year, we expect big

things from them."

Senior Alice Schmidt also expects to make major contributions to the team.

In 2003, she battled injuries and didn't see action in competition. Now, she's healthy and ready to contribute to the team.

"I'm really in shape," Schmidt said. "I'm so excited about this season."

With the return of proven veterans, as well as the development of young runners, the team expects to have a successful year.

Said Whittlesey, "Our goal is to be one of the top programs in the conference and put ourselves in position to be one of the top five or 10 in the country again."

## UNC takes strides to compete in ACC

While North Carolina cross country coach Michael Whittlesey has two Coach of the Year awards to his credit, neither are for his efforts with the men's team.

The men finished the 2003 season without winning any such honors. They were eighth overall in the ACC, finishing just ahead of Duke at the ACC Championships.

N.C. State, who won the 2003 men's competition, remains UNC's toughest competition this season, but the men are focused on improving their record and garnering a conference title.

The 2004 cross country season will open Sept. 11 at Wake Forest, where the men will have a chance to see where they stand in the ACC.

"The conference is very tight,"

Whittlesey said. "We're going to have to get in there and fight."

Junior Pablo Durana, who is studying abroad during this season, will not join in the fight. Durana was a top-five scorer during last season.

He was the team's top finisher at the North Carolina Collegiate Cross Country Championships in Greenville in 2003.

"Obviously, we could use him," said senior Brian McGovern. "But I'm pretty happy with the returning athletes."

The men will return all of their top five scorers including seniors Matt Daly, Jesse Rappole, McGovern and juniors Rob Robertson and Tom Falvey.

McGovern was first in the 2003 UNC Challenge meet with a time of 25 minutes, 40.63 seconds, and he finished three spots shy of the All-ACC team in 2002.

Part of the team's strategy is to have the top five men finish in high-scoring positions in every race. McGovern said that sophomore Felix Sebera and junior Erik Olsson could also be key contributors this year.

The varsity team is preparing for the eight-kilometer ACC races — District and NCAA races will be 10 kilometers — by building its endurance during these first few weeks of practice.

The team runs about 90 miles per week, followed by a series of abdominal exercises as well as stretches.

The extra endurance will be necessary if the Tar Heels want to challenge the elite teams in the conference, which include N.C. State and Florida State.

Still, McGovern is confident that with the depth the team has built and the extra work it is put-

ting in, a high finish at the NCAA Championships is well within reach.

"We know what we have," McGovern said. "We just need to run to our potential."

ATHENS, Greece — Larry Brown was right. The Americans did eventually start hitting their jump shots.

Stephon Marbury set a United States Olympic record with 31 points, and the team that spent the first week and a half of the Athens Games missing jumpers finally found its range in a 102-94 victory against Spain in the quarterfinals Thursday.

The Americans made 12 3-pointers and knocked the previously undefeated Spaniards out of medal contention with their best all-around performance of the games.

They didn't let a large foul disparity rattle them, knocked down their free throws when they needed them and surpassed 100 points for the first time in the tournament.

Marbury broke the U.S. record of 30 points shared by Charles Barkley (1992 vs. Brazil) and Adrian Dantley (1976 vs. Yugoslavia).

As the teams left the court, Brown and Spanish coach Mario Pesquera were pointing angrily at each other and had to be separated by their assistants.

Allen Iverson added 16 points, Carlos Boozer had 12 and Lamar Odom had 11 for the Americans,

who advanced to the semifinals to play Argentina on Friday.

Duncan scored the Americans' first five points and blocked Spain's first shot, but he was on the bench just 4 1/2 minutes into the quarter and stayed there for the rest of the first half after picking up two fouls. The U.S. team made four of its first five 3-point attempts, and the first quarter ended in a 25-25 tie.

The United States led 44-43 at halftime despite giving up 18 points to Spain's Pau Gasol and being called for 14 of the game's 19 fouls.

Marbury reached 21 points — matching his total from the Americans' first five games — on a 3-pointer in the third quarter.
