Panel won't back 12th football game

MIAMI - The Knight commission urged the NCAA to oppose the addition of a 12th regular-season game for Division I football teams until the effects of recent academic reforms for players become clear.

The NCAA Division Management Council has backed legislation that would allow Division I-A and I-AA schools to add a 12th game starting with the 2006 season

The NCAA Board of Directors on Thursday will consider the legislation, which has the support of most athletic directors. The Knight commission last week sent a memo to the NCAA board of directors.

The commission is a privately funded group formed in 1989 to promote reforms and greater presidential control of college sports.

The NCAA's latest academic reform movement is based on a point system that measures the retention and graduation rates of each team.

Teams that fail to meet minimum standards — about a 50 per-cent graduation rate — are in danger of losing scholarships. Teams

that consistently fall short of the NCAA's minimum requirements might face post-season bans.

According to the report released in February, half of the 328 Division I schools have at least one team that might face sanctions.

But North Carolina fared well in the report. Almost all of the 26 Tar Heel

varsity squads garnered an acceptable score under the new standards. Only the wrestling and men's golf teams fell below the minimum.

The men's basketball team got a erfect score, becoming one of only a handful of top-ranked teams to do so.

But until the effects of the new standards become clear, the Knight commission will hold its ground.

"This coming fall will be the first time juniors will be subject to the increased progress toward degree requirements, and the academic performance program will be in effect as well," the Knight commission wrote in its letter.

"The commission, by a substantial majority, urges the board to oppose the addition of a 12th foot-ball game until the impact of these academics reform is clear."

Hurricane aid centers

months after the remnants of tropical storms caused extensive damage in western North Carolina. centers opened Monday where residents can apply for help. Dubbed "Operation Brighter

Day," Recovery Application Centers in 50 disaster-declared counties opened in N.C. Cooperative Extension Center offices.

For western North Carolina, those counties include: Avery, Buncombe, Graham, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Macon, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Polk, Rutherford, Swain, Transylvania, Watauga and

Yancey. The area was the hardest hit by September's storms.

The remnants of Hurricane Frances struck Western North Carolina on Sept. 7, dumping more than 14 inches of rain on some areas. Nine days later, what was left of Hurricane Ivan hit the region with high winds and torrential rains.

Eleven people died. The storms caused millions of dollars in damage to homes and businesses. destroyed crops throughout the region and washed out or flooded more than 200 roads.

Almost six months after the disaster, the legislature approved and Easley on Feb. 25 signed the Hurricane Recovery Act, providing \$247.5 million in disaster relief for areas ravaged by the flooding. The centers provide a one-stop

application service for hurricane victims who exhausted other avenues of financial assistance and need additional aid. Applications will be accepted through May 27. The centers address concerns

that applicants would have to go to different agencies to get help. "We have so many portals of

entry, I don't know where people go to ask for what," Sen. Martin Nesbitt, D-Buncombe, said last week at a legislative meeting held to talk about state hurricane relief programs.

Hurricane victims who got help from their insurance companies or the Federal Emergency Management Agency and still have uninsured losses might be eligible for state financial aid. Types of help available include

repair or replacement of housing or private bridges and driveways, and agriculture and fish farm losses.

People interested can apply for all available North Carolina Individual Assistance programs at the same time.

more space than it needed at its more than 400 domestic facilities, though Defense Secretary Donald H. Rumsfeld recently suggested the surplus probably will be less given that 70,000 troops from overseas are returning soon to the United States. Previous closure rounds eliminated or realigned 451 instal-

lations, including 97 major ones. In an effort to limit political influence on the process, a ninemember commission - chosen by the White House and congressional leaders - works independently to vet the Pentagon list.

Still, Chris Kelley Cimko, who worked on base-closing commis-sions in the 1990s, said, "It's very, very hard to divorce yourself from the politics. You have to be very strong."

Commission Chairman Anthony Principi has pledged that his panel will be independent, fair and free of political influence. "National security will be our

highest priority," he told lawmak-ers last month. "I believe that if we politicize this process, we will only increase the level of cynicism around the country and really doom it to failure." He acknowledged in a written

questionnaire to the Senate Armed Services Committee that one of his challenges will be ensuring "all commissioners and staff remain impartial and avoid political pressure and conflicts of interest."

Administration aides say President Bush has been clear that national security — not politics — should dictate which bases are closed.
