Leaders still downloading wireless plans

Soon cell phone users might not be the only ones worrying about how many bars they're getting in Chapel Hill.

Since earlier this year, the Chapel Hill Downtown Partnership and the town's department of information technology have been examining plans to build a free community-wide wireless Internet zone.

Now, it seems, they finally might be raising the bar.

Tuesday, the Chapel Hill information technology committee, which is responsible for making recommendations to the Town

Council, held a special meeting to debate the initiative. "It's a question of will (wireless Internet) be used successfully" said Brian Russell, a committee member.

The committee hopes to present a plan to the council before the Nov. 8 elections. Many of this year's candidates have included wireless goals in their platforms.

Gregg Gerdau, chairman of the committee, said the debate centers on how best to deploy and pay for the service and the best model.

Gerdau said that in Palo Alto, Calif., a community similar in size and demographics to Chapel Hill, wireless has brought a competi-

tive advantage to area economics. "Wireless is a driver of business to downtown as opposed to going to a mall," he said.

Some business owners, even those who already provide wireless Internet access to their customers, are on board with the plan.

"Lots of my regulars enjoy having the access and this would be even more convenience," said Steve Dorozenski, owner of Jack Sprat

He said he wasn't worried about losing a competitive advantage for his business if all downtown begins to offer wireless. Many of those businesses already might be at a disadvantage, as the town of Carrboro began offering free wireless to its

downtown nearly a year ago. But Carrboro's success cannot be directly translated to Chapel Hill, officials have found. "Carrboro is a fairly low cost, simpler model," said Liz Parham, executive director of

the downtown partnership.
Gerdau also was complimentary of the Carrboro model but noted its constraints. "They were able to put up wireless Internet in downtown, at a reasonably small cost, but the

geography is different," he said.
Chapel Hill's downtown is spread
out, from Merritt Mill Road to the Morehead Planetarium and Science

Center, and many different constitu-encies are under review as possible wireless access points, Parham said.

And it's not even definite that the service would be provided only downtown. "We're looking at how we integrate with local schools, the University, public access, churches and other geographic districts," Gerdau said.

There are some in the community who think the underprivileged areas near downtown, such as the Northside and Pine Knolls communities, deserve special consideration because they historically have had an economic barrier to technology. "Neighborhoods classically under-

served by technology benefit tremendously by wireless," said Gerdau. Ultimately, adapting Chapel Hill for wireless access is a political issue, with the final decision coming down to the downtown partnership and the council. "There isn't much for us to do except recommend that the town do something," Gerdau said.

Once the committee decides the best choices, the partnership will move forward, Parham said.

"Once they decide the best appli-

cation for wireless, we'll know how to direct the next part."
