

Heels net tight win vs. WFU

For the majority of the season, the No. 4 North Carolina women's tennis team has ridden the backs of its talented juniors and freshmen

as usual for the Tar Heels. Led by juniors Jenna Long and Sara Anundsen — the No. 6 tandem in the country — UNC (20-3, 5-1 in the ACC) defeated Wake Forest in all three matches.

Long and Anundsen defeated No. 20 Alex Hirsch and Ashley Davis, 8-3, and UNC junior Caitlin Collins and freshman Laura Reichert dropped Ana Jerman and Christian Tara, 8-4.

"Overall, for us being able to come away with a victory like this against that kind of team gives our team a lot of confidence."

In the final match of the contest, Tanja Markovic defeated Sierra Poske, 6-1, 5-7, 6-0, to give UNC a 4-3 victory against the No. 17 Demon Deacons.

"We are feeling really confident," said Long of her continuing doubles dominance. "Everything is kind of clicking."

The victory against Wake Forest was important for ACC positioning as UNC tries to keep up with undefeated Miami and Georgia Tech.

"She is one that I feel very confident having in as the last match because she is going to do whatever it takes to win," UNC coach Brian Kalbas said of Markovic.

Kalbas said he felt good about the team's doubles play, too. "For us to win all three doubles matches today was a good effort," he said. "Laura and Caitlin played a great match today ... they deserve a lot of credit."

North Carolina is third in the conference and will square off against Maryland on Saturday and Boston College on Sunday at home.

On Wednesday, that meant battling a tricky freshman who refused to back down and forced Markovic to earn every point.

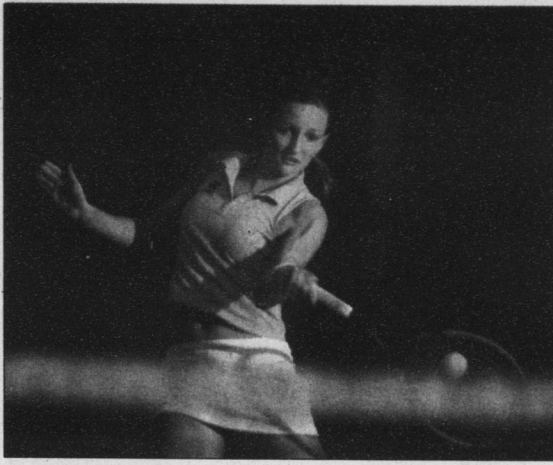
North Carolina needed that doubles point as the ultracompetitive Demon Deacons (9-5, 2-3) pushed UNC to the limit in singles play.

And it meant playing through pain from her injured hand and wrist — an injury that had sidelined Markovic earlier in the year.

No. 32 Long lost her singles match in three sets, falling 6-7, 6-3, 1-6 to No. 43 Hirsch. No. 95 Anundsen lost 3-6, 2-6 to No. 106 Jerman.

"I was just trying to not think about anything but the game," she said.

Wake Forest forced UNC into a style of play that featured long volleys and play around the net, causing the Tar Heels to commit unforced errors and creating situ-

MT. PLEASANT, S.C. — No. 23 North Carolina had to go to extra innings twice Wednesday but left with a sweep of the College of Charleston, 2-1 and 4-3.

Senior pitcher Crystal Cox picked up her seventh straight win in the opener, and second baseman Cassie Palmer had a pair of game-winning hits to lead the Tar Heels.

UNC (30-10) threatened only once in the traditional seven innings, when junior Marissa May was stranded on second in the fourth.

The Tar Heels finally broke the scoreless tie in the eighth, courtesy of Palmer's sixth home run of the year — giving the Tar Heels a two-run lead that they would never relinquish.

UNC wasted no time getting on the scoreboard in game two, taking a 1-0 lead in the top of the first thanks to an RBI single by Casey Testa.

Both team's bats would fall silent until the fourth, when Charleston (18-19) took its first lead of the day. Charleston maintained a 2-1 lead until junior Joslin Higgins' seventh inning home run tied the game at 2 — forcing extra innings.
