strators attacked international peacekeepers with rocks, gre-
nades and Molotov cocktails Monday, setting off the worst violence in Kosovo since it
declared independence from Serbia last month. Rallies of gunfire were
exchanged, injuring 132 ins exchanged, injuring 132 in hours
of clashes between U.N. and NATO forces and protesters outside a U.N. courthouse. The clashes began when the
U.N. stormed the courthouse to pull sut protesters who opposed Kosovo's independence.
