When advisers do recommend the providers, it's usually because they offer programs and locations that UNC lacks, and IES programs

also often require fewer foreign language skills, advisers said.

Lauren Ellis, a December graduate, said she chose COPA before meeting with advisers because it was UNC's only option in Mendoza,

COPA was developed by UNC with the University of Texas at Austin and the University of Illinois at Urbana-

Champaign to offer students more options in Latin America.

Miles said IFSA-Butler's involvement began so logistical issues involved with the program could be handled separately from academics.


