onsensus still not reached on workers' righ

Involves production of UNC apparel

Less than three weeks ago, five members of the Sweatfree Coalition a group that includes members of Student Action with Workers were placed under arrest and charged with failure to disperse after moving a peaceful protest into the South Building rotunda outside Chancellor James Moeser's office.

Now, the group faces a court date of June 23 and a still-ongoing battle to see UNC adopt the Designated

Suppliers Program, which selects manufacturing suppliers that hold to certain labor standards.

UNC student and organizer for Student Action with Workers, Salma Mirza, said the Designated Suppliers Program would guarantee workers who produce UNC apparel a living wage and the right to collective bargaining.

UNC had the highest-grossing collegiate merchandise royalty revenue in the nation in 2005, a portion of which comes from the

The University's Licensing Labor Code Advisory Committee voted in a special meeting May 2 not to join the Designated Suppliers Program, a decision that came on the heels of the SAW occupation of South Building. Despite many students' concerns

for the labor conditions of the workers who make UNC apparel, Moeser and some student leaders still hold reservations about the DSP.

Student Body President J.J. Raynor said she is hesitant to support the program because it might olate antitrust legislation.

Regardless of the chancellor's

decision, DSP cannot be formally implemented before 2009 due to a

U.S. Justice Department ruling Raynor also said the program's effect on prices of UNC apparel has yet to be determined.

Due to the unanswered ques-tions, Raynor said she currently does not have enough information

to support the DSP.
And Raynor has some influence on the Licensing Labor Code Advisory Committee, because stu-dent government is responsible for nominating two undergraduate members to the committee.

"What I really strongly encour-

Advisory Committee to do is to consider other ways that UNC can use its brand power to find other solutions that can be implemented now," Raynor said.

Forty-four other colleges and universities, including Duke University, have adopted the DSP.

Mirza said she wants to one day be able to wear her Carolina apparel with pride. She says the only way to ensure that for her is if the chancellor agrees to sign on with the DSP.

Raynor has made attempts to mediate the dispute, includ-

ing encouraging a conversation between administrators and protestors at the Sweatfree Coalition's outdoor protest April 17.

"We're really trying to find ways

to encourage consensus," she said. For now, Mirza and the rest of the members of SAW seem unlikely to strike a bargain.

They are still waiting on their court appearances and a decision of approval from Moeser.


