

Carolina Inn now under new management

Reason for switch remains unclear

Destination Hotels & Resorts officially took over management of the Carolina Inn from ARAMARK Harrison Lodging on Tuesday.

Previously, ARAMARK was responsible for all aspects of the Carolina Inn's operations.

"We pretty much ran the Carolina Inn," said David Freireich, spokesman for ARAMARK. Freireich listed sales, food and beverage service, reception and transportation among the many services

ARAMARK provided.

ARAMARK will still manage the University's dining halls, which are a separate contract from the Carolina Inn.

Mark Hickey, senior vice president of U.S. hospitality operations at Destination Hotels & Resorts, said that the company offered all former ARAMARK associates at the Carolina Inn employment that would allow them to continue in their positions.

"(The transition) has been pretty seamless," he said.

According to Hickey, the University officially selected Destination Hotels & Resorts as the new managers of the Carolina Inn about two months ago.

Hickey said that Destination Hotels & Resorts is impressed by the quality of operations at the Carolina Inn and that the company hopes to maintain and enhance the present Carolina Inn experience.

"We understand how important a historical property is to the community it serves," he said. "We understand and respect that."

Destination has experience managing historical properties such as

The Driskill Hotel in Austin, Texas, and the Tarrytown House Estate & Conference Center in New York.

The reason for the change in management is unclear. Associates at the Carolina Inn refused to comment, referring all questions to University Communications, which issued an official statement but provided no additional information.

The statement said, "The contract switch was not due to local performance. Rather, Destination Hotels & Resorts is a better strategic fit to operate the Inn."

Hickey said that he did not know what prompted the University's desire to change management. But

he did say the University contacted Destination Hotels & Resorts and "offered the opportunity to respond."

Hickey said the company welcomes the opportunity to manage the Carolina Inn. "We're looking at it as being the stewards of something special," he said.

For the Carolina Inn, Hickey

said the change in management does not mean a change in the operations of the Inn.

"We're doing a lot of listening," Hickey said. "It's not in our nature to come in and say that's how you need to run things."
