The Landenberg, Pa.-native is UNC's leading returning scorer after she racked up 39 points on nine goals and a team-best 21 assists in 2007. The only two Tar Heels to outscore Falgowski were Gey and Honda Award-winner Rachel Dawson, each of whom tallied 44 points.

While Gey no longer sports the Carolina blue No. 15 on game days, that won't stop her from getting out on the field at Henry Stadium during practice.

"She's going to be out here, still training," Shelton said. "She's got a long international future in front
