Team struggles with first loss

Breaks 25-game winning streak

WINSTON-SALEM — There they were. Stretching in silence.
Not talking. Not smiling. And

most importantly, not winning.

The customary postgame cool
down was anything but routine Sunday for the No. 1 North Carolina field hockey team, a squad that hadn't lost since Penn State knocked them out of the 2006 NCAA Tournament.

The sound of revelling Iowa players and fans was all that could be heard at Wake Forest's Kentner Stadium.

The scoreboard stood ominously at the opposite end of the field. staring down the melancholy Tar Heel squad from afar. HAWKEYES 3. TARHEELS 2.

The one-word UNC nickname was just one of the two glaring mistakes on the scoreboard. The score obviously had been reversed. The Tar Heels don't lose in field

But Sunday they did.
Immediately following the final horn, coach Karen Shelton let her team know exactly what she thought of the less-than-desirable outcome.

It was unacceptable.

And though she admitted later that certain teaching points can come from the defeat, how to be a good loser should never be one of them.

"Show me a good loser, and I'll show you a loser. We don't feel good about this - at all," Shelton said.

The Tar Heels embodied that attitude on their way off the field. Heading to the bench after the excruciating defeat, Shelton's play-

ers were stripping shin guards and goalkeeper gear as if the loss had saturated the equipment itself and they wanted to distance themselves from it as quickly as pos-

Fighting back tears and violently stuffing travel bags, the Tar Heels seemed to just want the experience to be over.

"That's what I think (Shelton) wants us to be angry about," junior forward Danielle Forword said. "We don't want to feel this again.

Perhaps North Carolina goalkeeper Brianna O'Donnell summed up the feeling of the team best. After pondering how exactly to express her feelings, all she could say was: "I really don't have words."

The schedule doesn't get any easier for UNC. The Tar Heels travel back to Kentner Stadium on Friday to play Wake Forest, who took down Iowa 3-2 Saturday.


