Laws of North Carolina. Passed at the session of 1832-33

CHAPTER I.

An Act to establish the Bank of North Carolina. Be it enacted by the General Assembly...

II. Be it further enacted, That the said bank shall consist of the principal bank at the seat of government...

III. Be it further enacted, That the Governor of the State, immediately after the rise of this Legislature...

IV. Be it further enacted, That the subscribers shall within ninety days, after their first General Meeting...

V. Be it further enacted, That the affairs of said bank shall be managed by eight directors...

VI. Be it further enacted, That the subscribers to said bank and their successors...

VII. Be it further enacted, That every cashier or clerk, before he enters on the duties of his office...

VIII. Be it further enacted, That the number of votes to which each stockholder shall be entitled...

IX. Be it further enacted, That the lands, tenements and hereditaments, goods and chattels...

their heirs, executors and administrators, in any court of record in the State...

XI. Be it further enacted, That the stock of said corporation shall be assignable and transferable...

XII. Be it further enacted, That the bills obligatory under the seal of the said corporation...

XIII. Be it further enacted, That the said corporation shall not deal in gold or silver coin or bullion...

XIV. Be it further enacted, That the said corporation shall not take more than the rate of six per cent...

XV. Be it further enacted, That if any person or persons holding any note or notes of said bank...

XVI. Be it further enacted, That a tax of one per cent per annum shall be levied on all stock held...

XVII. Be it further enacted, That the State of North Carolina, and any person or persons...

XVIII. Be it further enacted, That it shall be at all times lawful for a committee appointed by the General Assembly...

XIX. Be it further enacted, That after the time when the State shall become a stockholder in said bank...

XX. Be it further enacted, That if any cashier, clerk or other officer of said bank...

XI. Be it further enacted, That the directors shall be allowed to keep open the subscription books...

XII. Be it further enacted, That the notes or bills of said bank shall be received in payment...

XIII. Be it further enacted, That no officer of said bank shall be permitted to be indebted thereto...

CHAPTER II

An Act to vest the right of electing the Clerks of the County and Superior Courts...

III. And be it further enacted, That the sheriffs or other persons qualified to hold said elections...

IV. And be it further enacted, That the clerks elected under this act shall, at the first term...

V. And be it further enacted, That such person or persons and no others, who shall have attained...

VI. And be it further enacted, That this act shall be in force from and after the ratification...

CHAPTER III.

An Act making an appropriation, and appointing commissioners for the rebuilding of the Capitol...

II. And be it further enacted, That William Boylan, Duncan Cameron, William S. Mhoon...

III. And be it further enacted, That the general plan of the said Capitol, shall be the same...

IV. And be it further enacted, That the said commissioners are authorized to take charge...

V. And be it further enacted, That the said commissioners or a majority thereof...

VI. And be it further enacted, That the said commissioners shall have power to employ an architect...

CHAPTER IV.

An Act to repeal an Act, passed in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty...

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina, and it is hereby enacted...

II. Be it further enacted, That it shall be the duty of every Militia captain in this State...
