one million and fourteen thousand of the new American dollars. With these in hand, and they being legal tender, he could pay off his deposits with 500,000 of the coins and keep 518,000 of them as the reward of his shrewdness. His real profit would not be \$518,000. They would be cheap dollars, and compared with gold dollars, would possess but half their purchasing power...

Value of the New Coins

Mexico has her mints open to the free coinage of both gold and silver at the ratio of 16 to 1, but all of her gold goes abroad. She is hopelessly on the silver standard, and her dollars, heavier in weight and finer in quality than ours, have a value always rising or falling as the price of silver bullion rises and falls in the world's market...
