Cash wheat was in steady demand, the price ruling about 77c, while August was somewhat firmer, sales being made at 76c. No trade in September wheat. Private cables quiet, demand narrow and indifferent. Market closed easy; spot 76c bid; July 70c bid and 70c asked. Settling price, spot 76c; No. 3 red 74c; No. 2 red 73c; No. 2 red western 74c.
