Huebsch, Roman Catholic priest, who was serving a sentence of one year for criminal assault on a girl under the age of consent.

One of the principal arguments against the election of Governor "Ma" Ferguson was the record established hy her husband, James Ferguson, when he was governor, in pardoning criminals. It was pointed out that in the event of Mrs. Ferguson's election, the same practice might be employed. But a few weeks had elapsed after her inauguration when the pardon was issued setting Huebsch at liberty.

The case of this Roman prelate was a very prominent one here nearly four years ago. Huebsch was priest of a Roman Catholic church with 50 per cent, of the population of 13 mostly.
